The name “PreCana” comes from the Wedding Feast at Cana, where Jesus performed his first public miracle, changing water into wine. Pre means before, so before your personal Wedding Feast at Cana, your own wedding day, we help you prepare for the sacrament and start on your journey to a happy, healthy, and holy lifelong marriage.

This one-day PreCana is led by a trained married couple. Through short talks, sharing of the facilitators’ own experiences, group exercises, and personal reflection, couples are guided through topics useful for a successful future marriage. Some of the topics presented are the sacrament of marriage, couple prayer, family of origin, couple adjustment and growth, Catholic faith, natural family planning, conflict management, finances, and children.

Class starts at 9 a.m. and ends at 4:30 p.m. with a one-hour lunch break. You will receive a certificate of attendance at the end of the day which fulfills the marriage preparation requirement in the Archdiocese of Chicago.

The fee for PreCana is \$195 per couple. This covers the cost of the program, continental breakfast, handouts, workbooks, resources, and site rental.
